Project Resendem is organized by UMR IRICE (CRHI P. Griset) in association with the CEMMC of Université Bordeaux 3 (C. Bouneau et A. Fernandez), the UMR TRIANGLE (G. Pollet) and the UPR LCP (I. Veyrat-Masson).
